Format:

The Foil Team Premiership is a round robin competition where each school provides one team of each age category (U14, U16 and U19) to represent their school. Each school will fence the other schools' teams once in a round robin format via the organised fixtures. Points will be awarded for match victories and a tally is kept to determine the team premierships as well as the overall champion school. Estimated timing schedule per match:

- Match event 1 time allocation (1.25 hours): **8:00am to 9:15am**
(Allow 15 min break between matches)
- Match event 2 time allocation (1.25 hours): **9:30am to 10:45am**
(Allow 15 min break between matches)
- Match event 3 time allocation (1.25 hours): **11:00am to 12:30pm**

Special notes for the 2019 season:

- SICR is only able to provide one team of U14 this season. As such, SICR will forfeit all matches against the opposing U16 and U19 teams.
- NSBHS is only able to provide one team of U16 and one team of U19 this season. As such, NSBHS will forfeit all matches against opposing U14 teams.
- SICR and NSBHS matches have been placed on the same fixture line as they complement each other as a full set of three teams. The allocated number designation for this arrangement is '5/6' (SICR/NSBHS).
- KNOX is only able to provide one team of U14 and one team of U19 this season. As such, KNOX will forfeit all matches against the opposing U16 teams.
- All other schools have indicated that they can provide a full set of three teams.

Additional notes:

- Please allocate enough time to complete all match events at each fixture.
- Matches can start earlier if both teams and referees are available and willing to proceed.
- All teams must arrive at least 30 minutes before the first match event to help set up and warm up.
- All teams must stay until the last match event concludes.
- Every fixture has at least three schools attending. A match will be refereed by a member of the school that is not directly participating in the match.

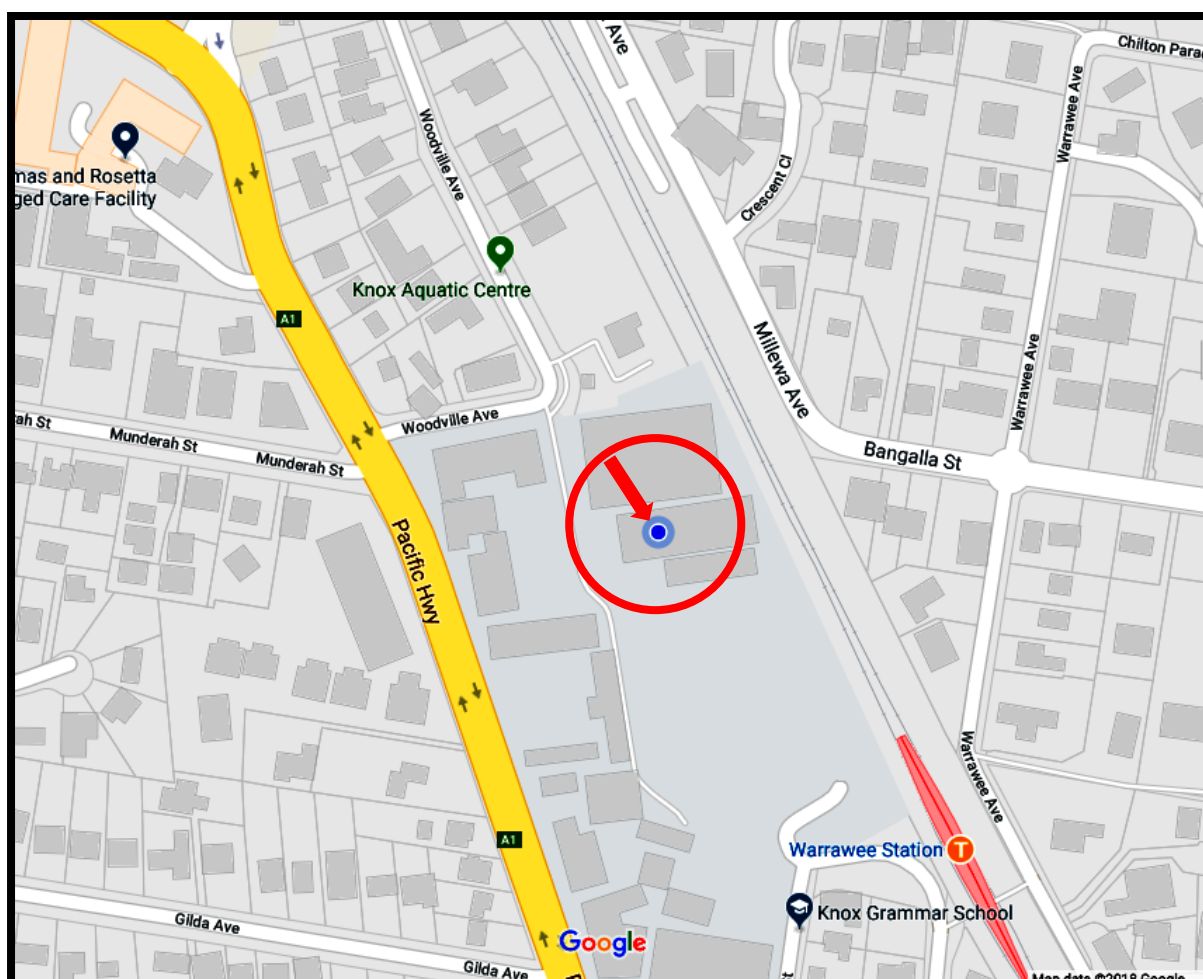

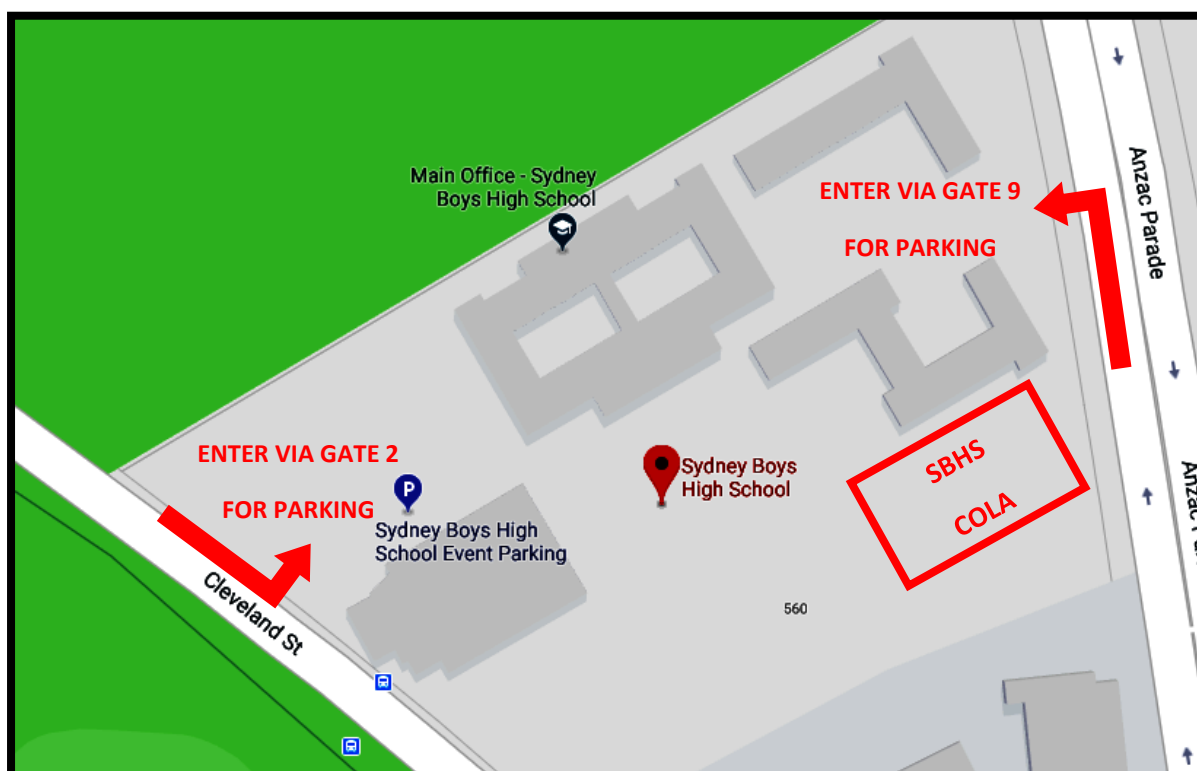

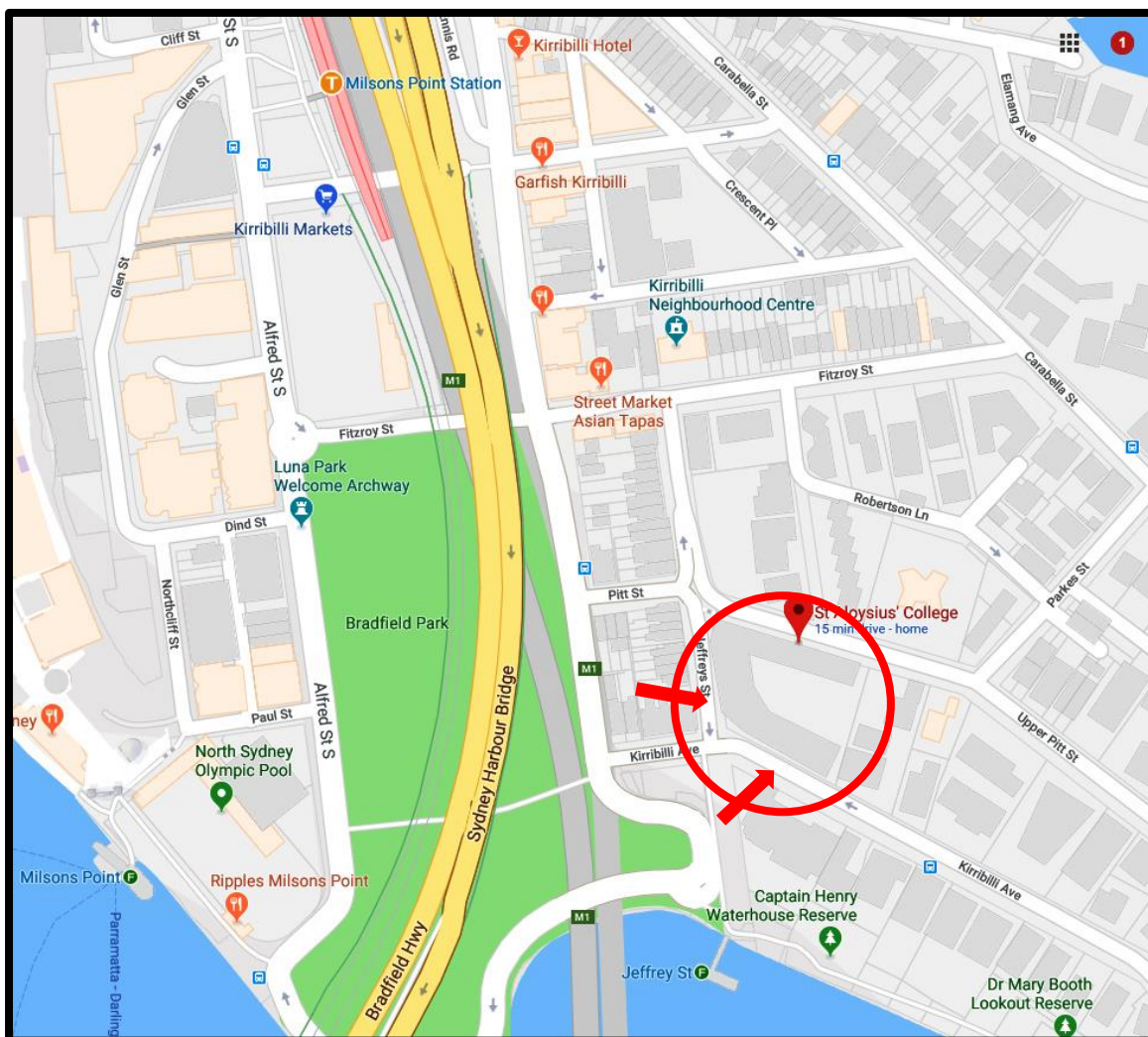
