Format:

The Foil Team Premiership is a round robin competition where each school provides one team of each age category (U14, U16 and U19) to represent their school. Each school will fence the other schools' teams once in a round robin format via the organised fixtures. Points will be awarded for match victories and a tally is kept to determine the team premierships as well as the overall champion school. Note: SICR (U14, U16) and AAS (U19) can fence the same opponent in the same round.

Estimated timing schedule per match:

- Match 1: time allocation (1.25 hours): 8:00am to 9:15am
 (Allow ~10 min break between matches)
- Match 2: time allocation (1.25 hours): 9:30am to 10:45am
 (Allow ~10 min break between matches)
- Match 3: time allocation (1.25 hours): **11:00am to 12:30pm**

Note: Matches may start earlier if both schools are ready to proceed.

Special notes for the 2022 season:

- SICR is only able to provide an U14 and U16 team this season. As such, SICR will forfeit all matches against the opposing U19 teams.
- AAS is only able to provide an U19 team this season. As such, AAS will forfeit all matches
 against the opposing U14 and U16 teams.
- All other schools have indicated that they can provide a full set of three teams.

Additional notes:

- Please allocate enough time to complete all match events at each fixture.
- Matches can start earlier if both teams and referees are available and willing to proceed.
- All teams must arrive at least 30 minutes before the first match event to help set up and warm up.
- All teams must stay until the last match event concludes.
- Every fixture has at least three schools attending. A match will be refereed by a member of the school that is not directly participating in the match.




