Designed For: Foil, Epee, Sabre fencers and Coach Professional Development. The Camp is for fencers of all capabilities but must be aged 12 & over (unless very fit/technically capable). Participants will be divided into weapon & competency groupings.

Format: The Camp is run as a collaboration of coaches from different clubs, states and countries. It is about bringing people together to work intensively and cooperatively, to develop skills, confidence and networks.

The Head Coach for The Camp will be Prof. Enrico di Ciolo from Pisa, Italy, leading his 7th Camp.

His student Paolo Pizzo won the 2017 Men's Epee World Championships. In 2012 he attended the CONI course for level IV technicians, the highest academic qualification for technicians in the Italian sports world.

Trainer of the National Fencing squad since 2014, he boasts a very wide experience at the highest level in all three weapons and has participated as Master of the Italian Nationals in three Olympics and numerous World and European Championships. He was awarded the silver palm of CONI and is a Knight of the Italian Republic for sporting merit.

Maestro Enrico has been a driving force for the UFC Camps and will lead a team of experienced Italian, Australian and New Zealand Coaches in Sydney.



Assistant Leader

Enrico is assisted in Camp direction by Maestra Virginia Di Franco. Virginia is a highly qualified coach and an experienced and successful fencer.

In June 2018 she passed the exam for the Italian Federal Technical level 3 to become a Maestro.

She initially trained as a coach under the legendary Antonio Di Ciolo, progressing rapidly from children's coaching to coaching at all levels. Virginia was Italian Champion at 14 years, a member of her National team at U20 winning a gold medal in the European Team Championship U20, and silver at the World Team U20 championships.

Virginia is a popular leader at the UFC Camps.

Giovanni has a big passion for fencing, and in 2019, at the age of 16 commenced training to become a referee for the Italian federation. To become a referee he followed a training course with most expert referee such as the current FIE GP Simona Pierucci, the head of GSA (gruppo arbitrale italiano, the Italian referee's association).

Giovanni will also present to fencers and coaches on refereeing at three weapons.

Leader of the Sydney University Fencing Club Speed & Agility Program. Bill assisted with direction of UFC8 and was a coach to the Australian Olympic Team, London 2012 and Tokyo 2020 Mod Pen Representative, Ed Fernon.
