Format:

The Foil Team Premiership is a round robin competition where each school provides one team of each age category (U14, U16 and U19) to represent their school. Each school will fence the other schools' teams once in a round robin format via the organised fixtures. Points will be awarded for match victories and a tally is kept to determine the team premierships as well as the overall champion school. Special notes for the 2022 season:

- Arden Anglican School (AAS) is only able to provide an U19 team this season. As such, AAS will forfeit all matches against the opposing U14 and U16 teams. Matches marked in red will be a bye for the respective team.
- All other schools have indicated that they can provide a full set of three teams.
- All host venues are to supply 6 pistes for each fixture (except for the final Saturday fixture at SBHS to provide more room for the end of season Sausage Sizzle celebration).

Additional notes:

- Please allocate enough time to complete all match events at each fixture.
- Matches can start earlier if both teams and referees are available and willing to proceed.
- All teams must arrive at least 30 minutes before the first match event (8am) to help set up and warm up.
- All teams must stay until the last match event concludes.
- Every fixture has all schools attending. A match will be refereed by a member of the school that is not directly participating in the match.
- All schools must provide sufficient referees for the fixtures.

Entry Fee:

\$100 for NSWSFL Membership per competing school in the Foil program for the 2023 season. This fee helps to cover the cost of medals and any miscellaneous expenses in the running of the NSWSFL Foil program. The fee will be invoiced to the member schools by the Manager of the NSWSFL Foil Program.

Opportunity for supporting parents:

Host school parents of fencers may choose to assist with providing food/snacks via a sausage sizzle or cake/food stall at their host venue. This opportunity can help build relationships between schools, raise money for the school's respective fencing programs and keep hungry fencers fed.

SBHS will be hosting the final fixture with a sausage sizzle to celebrate the conclusion of the NSWSFL Foil Team Premiership season. A request for the number of attending guests from each school will be made closer to the date so that we can manage the catering for this event. More details will be provided closer to the date.

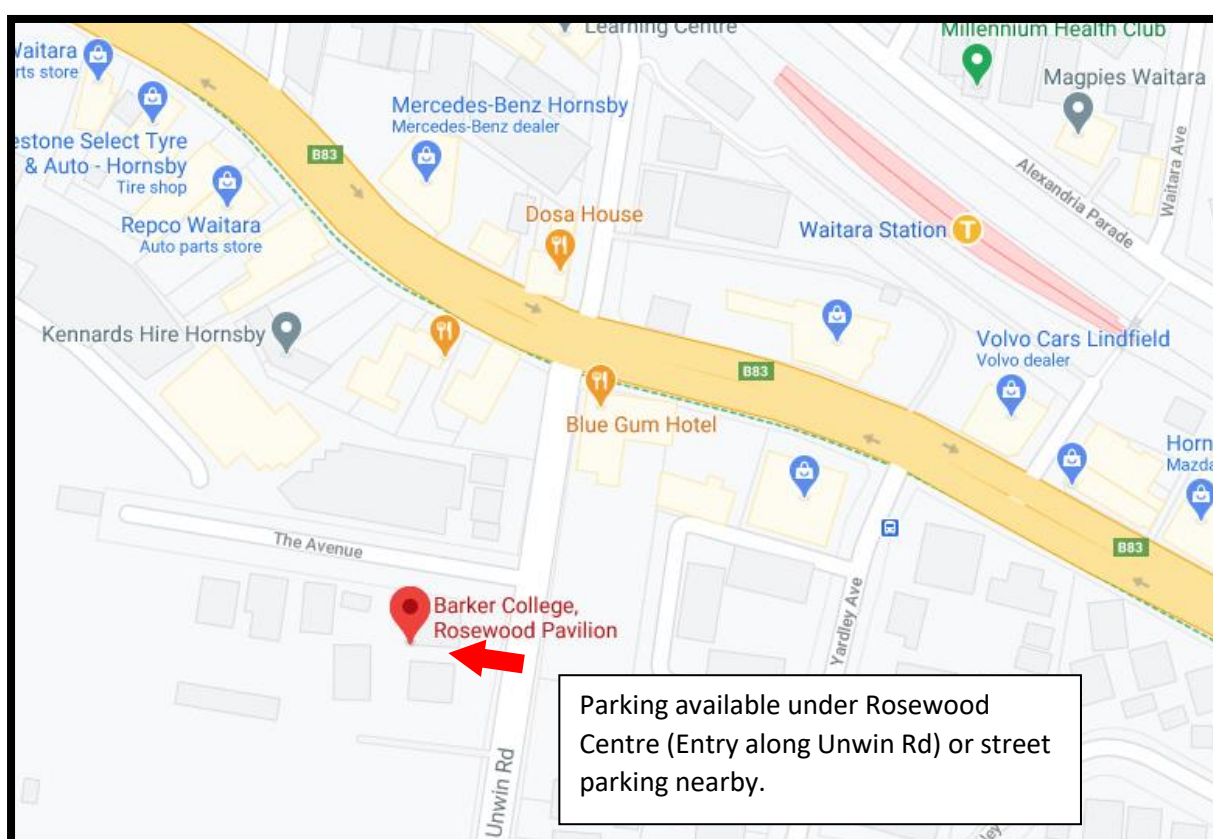

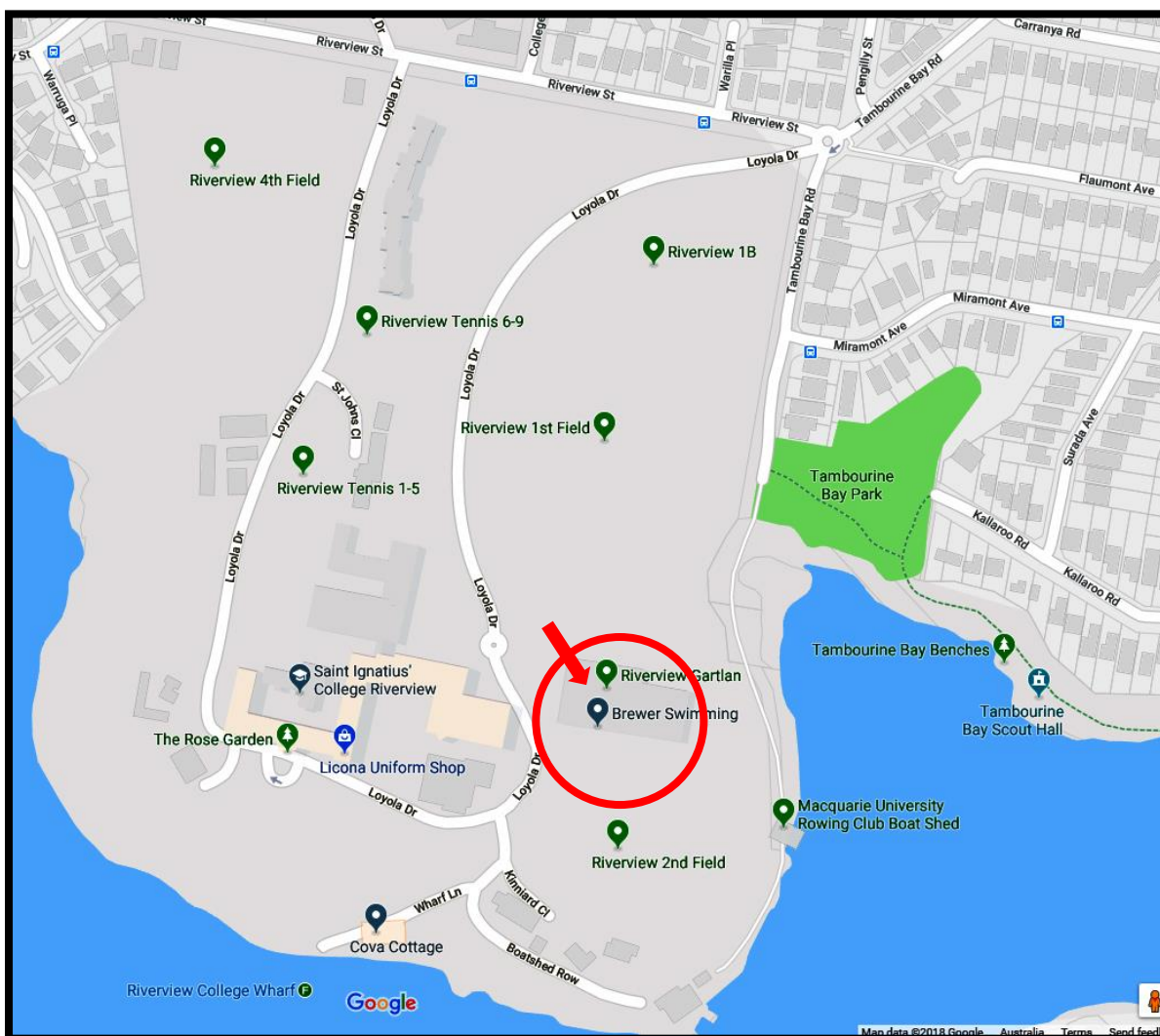
